Extending its artistic exposure, artgenève invites PAD Genève for its 2018 edition. The exhibitor's list includes galleries dealing in Decorative Arts, Historical and Contemporary Design.

Connecting the two legendary celebration of art through its modern and contemporary roots of design, artgenève invites PAD to enrich its artistic offerings at PAD Genève 2018. The fair has been remodeled keeping in mind the changing scenario of big art fairs that focus more on the diversity of the artworks rather than the number of exhibitors involved. These two art fairs collaborate to bring together 25 art galleries from Europe and from around the world.

The galleries that will offer 20th century Decorative Arts include 18 Davies Street Gallery from the UK; Galerie Marcilhac from France; Anne Autegarden, Belgium; Galerie Marcelpoil, France; Botella, France; Modernity, Sweden; Chahan, France; Alexandre Guillemain, France; Patrick Gutknecht, Switzerland; Jacques Lacoste, France; Galerie Latham à Genève, Switzerland; and 88 Gallery Paris/Hong-Kong - Maison Rapin.

Contemporary Design will be brought to the exhibition ensemble by galleries like Garrido Silver Gallery from Spain; Gosserez from France; Galerie Italienne from France; Hom Le Xuan from France; Priveekollektie Contemporary Art from the UK; Achille Salvagni from the UK; Galerie Armel Soyer from France; Hervé Van der Straeten from France; and Maria Wettergren from France.
