The PAD sets up in Geneva

After Paris and London, the temple of "French-style" interior design will be found on the shores of Lake Geneva from 1 to 4 February, invited by Art Genève to share its space. Twenty-five galleries from France, Belgium, the UK, French-speaking Switzerland, Spain and Sweden are taking part in the "adventure". So, a limited range for this first edition in Geneva ("It's just the beginning" says its director Patrick Perrin), with a conventional selection focusing on sound investments in 20th century decorative art, like Ruhlmann, Dupré-Lafon and Jouve.
