INTRODUCING

**Rasmus Warnke Nørregaard and Jacob Kam**

There was a collective gasp when Scandinavian furniture retailer Skandium went into administration last May. Founded in 1999 by Magnus Englund, Christina Schmidt and Christopher Seidenfaden, the company had something of a cult status, with two London showrooms. It has since been bought by Rasmus Warnke Nørregaard and Jacob Kam, the Danish entrepreneurs behind everclassic.com, an online marketplace for vintage Scandinavian design. 'We couldn't bear to see Skandium close down,' says Rasmus, who had been a frequent visitor. He and Jacob (pictured below from left) have gone east and recently opened a two-storey shop on Bacon Street, E1. As well as familiar names such as Carl Hansen & Søn and Gubi, the new Skandium also sells pieces by up-and-coming brands such as Danish lighting company Nuura.
